Sisters, Brothers,

Over 175,000 construction workers in the province of Québec are planning a general strike at midnight tonight. I encourage you to respect their picket lines should they take strike action.

The demands of these workers are legitimate and aim to improve their lives and the lives of their families. They have the full support and solidarity of Teamsters Canada.

Close to 10,000 of these workers are members of the newly chartered Teamsters Local AMI.

In the event of a strike, I have assured Local AMI's principal officer, Rénald Grondin, that I will be at his side at the gathering of the Trade Union Alliance at 6 a.m. tomorrow morning, at the Le Rizz Reception Hall located at 6630 Jarry Street East in Montréal.
